









The ceremonial father of Shu'laawisi wears white cotton trousers and shirt held in at the waist by a white embroidered sash tied at the right side, with a dressed deer skin hanging back from his shoulders, a streak of micaceous hematite dusted across his nose and eyes under his eyes - He carries a basket tray of te'likinawe, composed of eagle plumes taken from the under side of the tail, and other feathers, a mili, and a sacred meal basket, from which he sprinkles meal
